The Jewish Connection Network 2026 Purim Party: Masquerade Madness

Opportunity: Show your support for a growing community organization by sponsoring the Macks Jewish Connection Network's inaugural Purim Party, a Saturday evening friend-raiser and fund-raiser expected to attract 200 people from across Jewish Baltimore. This event will support the Network's [Community Connectors program](#), a cohort of 40 grass-roots community organizers, trained and supported by the Jewish Connection Network to build Jewish friendships and help people connect to Jewish life. Event Specifics: The Purim Party will be an adults-only community event on Saturday, February 28, 2025, 7:30-10:30 pm at Suburban Country Club in Pikesville, MD.

What is a Purim Party? Purim is a holiday that commemorates Queen Esther and her compatriots saving the Jewish people of Persia from a royal edict calling for their death. Celebrations for the holiday of Purim are focused on communal gatherings such as adult-focused celebrations featuring costumes and drinks. At a time when the Jewish community in America is feeling vulnerable, Purim is a celebration of communal resilience and women's leadership.

What is the Macks Jewish Connection Network? The [Macks Jewish Connection Network](#) was created by The Associated in 2022 to reverse downward engagement trends in communal life, addressing the loneliness epidemic throughout the United States by encouraging people to live connected lives of meaning. The Network's mission is to empower individuals to explore and deepen their own Jewish journeys—inspiring them to form lasting connections to a diverse, inclusive and vibrant Baltimore Jewish community.

In three years, the Network has engaged over 5,200 people, 69% of whom were not previously engaged in Jewish communal life. We work with young adults, families raising children, and empty nesters. Our constituents live in Baltimore County, Baltimore City, Carroll County and Harford County. A high percentage of people involved in The Network are transplants to Baltimore and part of an interfaith household.
